#### **Event Details:**

Required Forms (due on or before Thursday, September 8, 2011):

1. All students (including those over the age of 18) are required to turn in a permission slip in order to attend the event. Valid Parent/Guardian signatures are required; however Teacher signatures are NOT necessary on this permission slip.

#### Transportation:

- 1. Event location: Kettering University's Connie and Jim John Recreation Center, 1700 West University Avenue, Flint, MI.
- 2. The Team will be meeting at Premier Tooling Systems to caravan to the event; however **students and Mentors are responsible for their own transportation to the event** (we will NOT be assigning drivers for this event).
- 3. Students may NOT drive any other student. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 4. Students in need of transportation to the event should contact Clinton or Brandi to arrange a ride.
- 5. Free parking is available at the Recreation Center, and admission is free.
- 6. Please be punctual! Students who are not present at the time of departure will lose the opportunity to carpool with the rest of the team.
- 7. At the end of the event, Students should be picked up from Premier Tooling Systems at the designated time.

#### Food:

#### Friday:

- 1. Students and Mentors should eat lunch or a snack prior to leaving for the competition.
- 2. The Team will be pitching in for pizza on Friday night. Please see Brandi on or before September 8 to place your order.
- 3. Concessions will not be available for dinner on Friday night. If you wish to eat at the competition, you must pre-order your dinner with Brandi or bring a bagged meal.
- 4. Students and Mentors may also bring additional snacks or beverages to be consumed throughout the competition.

#### Saturday

- 1. Students and Mentors should eat breakfast at home prior to travel (if desired).
- 2. Students and Mentors should bring money to purchase lunch from the Concession Stands.

### Uniform:

- 3. Students, Team Mentors, and any guests in attendance must wear closed-toe tennis shoes or boots in the Pit Area.

## Other Considerations:

- 1. Students, Mentors, Parents, and Guests are expected to be on their best behavior while with the Team, and must adhere to the Team Member Basic Conduct Guidelines and Team Member Expectations at all times. Per these agreements, any behavior or action(s) deemed inappropriate or detrimental to the Team (at the discretion of Head Mentors or School Liaison), will result in the Student's immediate dismissal from the competition. The Team will not be responsible for transporting the Student home; he/she must be picked up by his/her parents. The Team will NOT cover any cost to send a Student home due to inappropriate behavior.
- 2. While in the Pit area, any guest under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 3. The venue will be equipped with stadium-style seating. Please take into consideration any provisions that may need to be made for your personal comfort.
