Required Forms and Information

1. All GBHS Students (including those 18 years and older) must complete the permission slip for this event.
 - Valid Parent/Guardian signatures are required.
 - Teachers do not need to sign this permission slip.
 - Permission slips must be returned to Brandi on 11/10/16 or upon the Student's arrival at the event.
2. All Students must complete the "2016 VEX Team Contract" before they attend as a member of the Team, or without parent supervision.
 - If you have not completed this document, please see Brandi during a Team Meeting to obtain a copy.
3. Team Members should sign up to receive Team Text Message Alerts via Remind

Meal Information:

1. Food will not be provided (by the Team) at this event.
2. Concessions will be available at the event.
 - a. You will be responsible for eating when you are hungry.
 - b. There will be a lunch break, but you can get food before or after the designated time.
 - c. The following items will be available, at the cost indicated below:
 - \$0.50 - 8oz cups of Coffee and Hot Chocolate
 - \$ 1 - Cans of Pop, Gatorade, Bottles of Water, Candy, Chips, Pretzels, Donuts, Bagels, Etc.
 - \$ 2 - Pizza by the Slice
 - \$ 3 - Individual Subs
3. You may pack a lunch if you do not wish to purchase concessions.
4. Please bring a reusable water bottle (please label with your name and our FRC Team Number) or sufficient funds to stay hydrated throughout the event.
5. We may be going out for an unofficial Team dinner afterwards. If you would like to join us, please bring \$15-\$20 for food. Location will be determined by a consensus of people attending the dinner.

Uniform Guidelines:

1. Students in attendance must wear a Team shirt (Red, Black, Mechanic, Banquet, Train, etc). Team Hoodies and Track Jackets may be worn at any time.
2. Students should wear appropriately styled jeans, shorts, Capri pants or an appropriate length skirt that is professional in appearance and wear a belt if necessary.
 - NOTE: Leggings are only permitted if there is a garment (skirt or shorts) worn over. **Leggings are NOT pants.**
3. Wear closed-toe shoes. Do not wear sandals.



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4. If you would like to wear a long-sleeve that does not display Team 2337 as outer-wear, please take it off during matches if you are on the Drive Team.
 - Team Sweatshirts are available for \$25.00 (limited sizes and styles, see Brandi for availability)
 - Team T-shirts are available for \$8.00 each, sizes and quantities are limited.
5. Students and mentors are responsible for bringing their own safety glasses to and from the event. Extras will not be available.

Transportation and Attendance Policies:

1. All students wishing to attend this event are responsible for arranging and paying for their own transportation to and from the event. Carpooling is encouraged, and should be arranged by individual families/students.
2. We will be meeting at Bloomfield High School. PLEASE BE ON TIME, we will need help with unloading, and the more hands we have, the easier the workload will be.
3. One year, no boys attended this event, and it was very disappointing. Male members of the Team are strongly encouraged to attend, and take into consideration the message they are sending by not supporting the female members of the Team by not attending
4. Parents, friends, and family are encouraged to attend. This event is free and open to the public.
 - Guests wishing to enter the pit area must be wearing closed-toe shoes and safety glasses
 - Team Shirts are also available for friends and family at the same price as Students. See Brandi for details.
 - Spectator viewing area has bleacher-style seating. Please bring any necessary items to ensure your personal comfort.

Behavior Expectations:

1. Students and Guests are expected to be on their best behavior while traveling with the Team, and must adhere to the 2016 VEX Team Contract. Per these agreements, any behavior or action(s) deemed inappropriate or detrimental to the Team (at the discretion of Head Mentors and/or School Liaison), will result in immediate dismissal from the event. The Team will not be responsible for any costs associated with early dismissal from any event.
2. Public Displays of affection and horseplay will not be tolerated.
3. Parents, friends and family in attendance are also expected to behave in a manner that reflects Gracious Professionalism and represents Team 2337, Grand Blanc High School, and Team 2337's sponsors in a positive way. Any guests behaving inappropriately may be asked to leave.

Tournament Guidelines:

Because this is an off-season "Girls Only" tournament, some special rules apply:

1. Robot driver, operator, human player and pit crew must be high school aged girls.
2. Male team members ARE STILL ENCOURAGED AND EXPECTED TO ATTEND, and will be in the pit throughout the competition, but only in support/advisory role. While the boys cannot actually perform maintenance and repair on the robot, they will be directing the girls during repairs, pre-match inspections and post-match robot check-ups. (Special circumstances require approval by pit admin.)
