Required Forms and Information

1. There is no permission slip to attend this event
2. All Students must complete the "VEX Team Contract" before they attend ANY Team events at Premier, including League Night
 - If you have not completed this document, please see Brandi during a Team Meeting to obtain a copy.
 - Team Captains should ensure that ANYONE attending meetings and working with his/her Team has completed the required paperwork after the first meeting attended.
3. If possible, Team Members should sign up to receive:

Meal Information:

1. Please bring a reusable water bottle (please label with your name) or sufficient funds to stay hydrated throughout the event. The back room is HOT during the summer and fall.
2. The EngiMART is open, with beverage selections ranging from \$0.50 to \$1.25.

Uniform Guidelines:

1. Wear closed-toe shoes. Do not wear sandals.
2. Students are responsible for bringing their own safety glasses to and from the event. Extras will not be available.
 - If you have paid your VEX Team fee and have not received your ONE included pair, please see Brandi at a Team meeting.

Transportation and Attendance Policies:

1. All students wishing to attend this event are responsible for arranging and paying for their own transportation to and from the event. Carpooling is encouraged, and should be arranged by individual families/students.
2. Parents, friends, and family are encouraged to attend. This event is free and open to the public.
 - The back room at Premier is hot, and there's not really any seating. Guests in attendance will be standing to watch matches for the duration of the event.
2. Teams may NOT gain access to Premier outside of the Team's regularly scheduled meetings.

Behavior Expectations:

1. Students and Guests are expected to be on their best behavior while participating in ALL Team events, and must adhere to the 2017 VEX Team Contract. Per these agreements, any behavior or action(s) deemed inappropriate or detrimental to the Team (at the discretion of Head Mentors and/or School Liaison), will result in immediate dismissal from the event. The Team will not be responsible for any costs associated with early dismissal from any event.
2. Public Displays of affection and horseplay will not be tolerated.
3. Parents, friends and family in attendance are also expected to behave in a manner that reflects Gracious Professionalism and represents Team 2337, Grand Blanc High School, and Team 2337's sponsors in a positive way. Any guests behaving inappropriately may be asked to leave.

Tournament Guidelines:

1. All work completed outside of Team meetings should include ALL members of the Team, if possible. Team Captains and Team Members should make a considerable effort to involve new Students in every step of the design, build, and competition process.
